Glass and solid partitioning were used to create the additional meeting rooms which were named after influential people such as Trevor Baylis, inventor of the wind-up radio, and John Logie Baird, inventor of the television. Manifestation and graphics were used to display the meeting room names and add a touch of colour to the space.

Office profile supplied a variety of furniture including task seating, huddle sofas with high backs for privacy and meeting room furniture.
