Tower Hamlets Homes appointed Office Profile to create a fun, agile working environment for their new office in the London Docklands.

Instead of a standard, formal office they wanted an enthusing, inspiring space that reflected their company values. There were various areas spread across three floors; open plan offices, washrooms with and without showers, breakout spaces, teapoints, meeting rooms and offices.

In the open plan office areas, we provided Myriad desking with some electric sit/stand desks to allow for agile working. Throughout all three floors, we designed patterned carpet and vinyl in the corporate colours. Glass partitions for meeting rooms and offices were built with famous influential people from the area incorporated within the design of the manifestation.

New vibrant teapoints were created on each floor complete with filtered boiling water points and glass splashbacks.
